THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE CONTROLLER OF SUPPLIES, TRANSPORT  
AND MARKETING UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 55.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor under paragraph (1) of Defence Regulation 55 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, duly delegated to me under paragraph (2) of the said Defence Regulation, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Control of Motor Transport) Order, 1947.

2. Notwithstanding anything in any Law or public instrument contained, from and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* no motor vehicle plying for hire and no motor lorry, whether plying for hire or not, shall be used on any road within the Colony, except under a permit granted under my hand or under the hand of any person authorized by me in writing in that behalf, and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in such permit.

3. Nothing in this Order contained shall apply to any motor vehicle belonging to His Majesty's Forces.

4. Any person who acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946.

5. The Defence (Control of Motor Transport) Order, 1942, and the Supplies and Services (Control of Motor Transport) (Amendment) Order, 1947, are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder :

Provided that any permit issued under the Orders hereby revoked and subsisting on the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette* shall be deemed to be a permit issued under and for the purposes of this Order.
