2. This appointment is in addition to and not in derogation of any other appointment made for the purposes of the said Defence Regulations or any of them in respect of any officer or person other than :---

(a) the Controller of Supplies;

(b) the Controller of Transport & Marketing; and

(c) the person appointed under Notification No. 176 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 23rd May, 1946,

but without prejudice to anything done by any such officer or person.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 31.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 31 of the Immigration Laws, 1936 to 1939, do hereby make the following regulations :----

1. These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Immigration Regulations, 1936 and 1939, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Immigration Regulations, 1936 to 1946.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after regulation 11 of the following regulation :---

"11A. The list to be furnished under section 14 of the Laws by the master of a ship and the pilot of every passenger carrying aircraft arriving from any place outside the Colony or departing from the Colony shall be in the Form B of the Second Schedule hereto and shall contain the information therein set out,"
