#### BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

### A PROCLAMATION.

R. E. TURNBULL,

Acting Governor.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the boundaries of the Villages of Athienou and Melousha, in the District of Larnaca.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Roland Evelyn Turnbull, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of April, 1947, the area described in the Schedule hereto, heretofore reckoned within the boundaries of the village of Melousha in the District of Larnaca, shall form part of the lands of the village of Athienou in the District of Larnaca and that the boundaries of the said villages of Melousha and Athienou shall be altered accordingly.

#### SCHEDULE.

The boundary commences at the junction of roads at the most northern point of Plot No. 1 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXI/ 30, locality "Merijes", which point is also on the boundary of the Nicosia and Famagusta Districts, and proceeds south-eastwards along the said district boundary to the junction of roads at the most northern point of Plot No. 32 of the said plan; thence south-eastwards along the road leading to the village of Melousha to the most eastern point of Plot No. 21 of the said plan; thence southwards and westwards along the boundaries of and including Plots Nos. 21, 20, 234, 230, 224, 223, 215 and 214 of the said plan to a road at the south-western corner of the last mentioned plot; thence south-eastwards along the said road to the north-eastern corner of Plot No. 71 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXI/38, locality "Bambajera"; thence southwards and westwards along the boundaries of and including Plots Nos. 71, 70, 66, 63, 64, 21, 23, 49, 48, 38 and 39 of the said plan, to the road at the south-eastern corner of the last mentioned plot; thence westwards along the said road leading to the village of Athienou to the junction of roads at the south-western corner of Plot No. 31 of the said plan; thence northwards along the road to the village of Ayia to the point of commencement.

All which said area comprises 811 donums or thereabouts as shown edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1344.
