(2) No person shall in the street below named, during the months of June to September of each year, both inclusive, from 6 o'clock p.m. till 11 o'clock p.m. lead, ride, drive or take any animal or vehicle in the direction mentioned against the name of such street along the portion of the street specified:

Gladstone Street: The direction leading to the junction of Karaiskakis and Gladstone Streets, along the portion of the street which is between Ayia Phylaxis Street and the corner of Karaiskakis Street.

(3) The Council shall place sign posts at suitable spots, particularly at points where other streets debouche into the above-named streets, indicating the direction in which animals and vehicles may move along the above-named streets.

168B. The prohibitions contained in this Part of these bye-laws

shall not apply to bicycles pushed by pedestrians".

The above bye-laws have been approved by His Excellency the Acting Governor. (M.P. 806/11/2.)
