

Repeal of section 60 of the Principal Law and substitution of new section.

2. The following section shall be substituted for section 60 of the Principal Law :—

“ 60. There shall be levied, assessed, collected and paid in every year an additional tax on all property which is subject to Immovable Property Tax. In towns the additional tax shall be at the rate of four per thousand and in villages at the rate of one and a half per thousand on the capital value of immovable property which is subject to Immovable Property Tax.”

A LAW TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS, EXCISE AND REVENUE LAW, 1899.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs, Excise and Revenue (Amendment) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Customs, Excise and Revenue Law, 1899, (hereinafter referred to as “the Principal Law”).

Addition of new section to Principal Law.

2. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following section as section 36 :—

“ 36. From and after the first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, there shall be levied upon the exportation of silk cocoons which have been produced in Cyprus an export duty at the rate of one shilling and three copper piastres per oke :

Provided that the Governor may at any time by a notification published in the *Cyprus Gazette* abolish such duty.”
