BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment (No. 3) Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, as amended by the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment Law, 1932, and the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment (No. 2) Law, 1932, (hereinafter together referred to as "the Order").

2. The Third Schedule to the Order is hereby amended by the addition of the words " , if the Comptroller of Customs is satisfied that they are of British Empire origin " at the end of items 12, 13, 14 and 15 respectively.

BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. 2. The First Schedule to the Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(b) The expressions

Made wholly or mainly of leather with leather or rubber soles:—

Children's sizes:

Football boots .. 2s. per pair.”

shall be substituted for the expressions

“Boots and Shoes:—

Wholly or mainly of leather:—

Men's .. ..	5s.	per pair.
Women's .. ..	4s.	per pair.
Children's .. ..	2s.	per pair.
Babies' .. ..	4cp.	per pair.

Wholly or mainly of canvas:—

Men's and women's	1s.	per pair.
Children's and babies'	3cp.	per pair.

Other (excluding boots and shoes made wholly of rubber) 2s. per pair.”

(c) The expression

“Soap, other than perfumed or toilet .. .. 4cp. the oke.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Soap, other than perfumed or toilet .. .. 2cp. the oke.”

(d) The expression

“Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials .. £1. 2s. 4½cp. the gallon.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials .. 15s. the gallon.”

(e) The expression

“Tobacco, manufactured 17s. 4½cp. the oke.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Tobacco, manufactured 14s. the oke.”

(f) The expression

“Tobacco, manufactured, cigars .. .. 8s. 7cp. the 100.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Tobacco, manufactured, cigars .. .. 7s. the 100.”

(g) The expression

“Tobacco, manufactured, cigarettes .. .. £1. 7s. 4½cp. the oke.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Tobacco, manufactured, cigarettes .. .. 22s. the oke.”

(h) The expressions

“Wines in bottle:—

Sparkling .. .. 18s. the gallon.

Other .. .. 13s. 4½cp. the gallon.”

shall be substituted for the expressions

“Wines in bottle:—

Sparkling .. .. 12s. the gallon

Other .. .. 9s. the gallon.”

(i) The expression

“Wines in wood .. .. 7s. 4½cp. the gallon.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Wines in wood .. .. 5s. the gallon.”

3. The Second Schedule to the Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) The expression

“Medicines, not exempted from duty.. £15.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Medicines, patent or proprietary,  
claiming curative or remedial prop-  
erties .. .. £15.”

(b) The expression

charged with duty, and top-boots,  
hip-boots, sandals, slippers and  
galoshes .. .. £30.”

shall be inserted in its appropriate alphabetical place therein.

4. Item 41 of the Third Schedule to the Order is hereby repealed and the following item substituted therefor:—

5. The Fourth Schedule to the Order is hereby amended as follows:—
