A LAW TO AMEND THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS PROTECTION  
LAWS, 1922 TO 1927.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection (Amendment) Law, 1933, and shall be read as one with the Game and Wild Birds Protection Laws, 1922 to 1927, (hereinafter called the "Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Protection Laws, 1922 to 1933.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion of sub-section (3) and the marginal note thereto and the substitution of the following therefor:—

"Licences  
to whom  
granted.

(3) No licence under this Law shall be granted to any person unless such person is in possession of a firearms licence issued under the provisions of the Firearms Law, 1933, and which is in force at the time a licence under this Law is issued. No fee or charge shall be taken or made for the issue of a licence under this Law."

(b) by the deletion of sub-section (4) and the marginal note thereto and the substitution of the following therefor:—

"Duration  
of licence.

(4) A licence under this Law other than one granted under the provisions of section 5 (3) hereof shall commence on the 11th September and shall expire on the 20th January."

3. Section 5 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion of the words "1st February to the 19th August" in sub-section (1) and by the substitution therefor of the words "21st January to the 10th September";

(b) by the deletion of the words "1st April and 19th August" in sub-section (5) and by the substitution therefor of the words "21st January to the 10th September".

4. Section 6 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the words "three months" of the words "and shall in addition be ordered to pay a fine of one shilling for each egg in respect of which the offence has been committed".

5. Section 11 (2) of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "one permanent reserve" and by the substitution therefor of the words "two permanent reserves".

6. Section 20 of the Principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

"Reward to  
informers.

20. Where any person upon conviction has been sentenced to pay a fine for any offence against this Law the Governor may grant a reward not exceeding one-half of any such fine when recovered to any person whose information has, in his opinion, led to such conviction."
