A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROHIBITION OF EXPORT OF
ARMS, AMMUNITION AND OTHER STORES.

Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering
the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the
Colony of Cyprus as follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Exportation of Arms Short title.
(Prohibition) Law, 1949.

Governor
may prohibit
exportation
of arms, etc.

2. The Governor may by Proclamation from time to time prohibit the exportation either generally or to any country or place therein named, or the carriage coastwise of all or any of the following articles, namely, arms, ammunition, aircraft, military and naval stores, and any article which in the opinion of the Governor is capable of being converted into or made useful in increasing or maintaining the quantity of arms, ammunition, aircraft, or military or naval stores.

Forfeiture
and
penalties.

3. If any articles, the export whereof is prohibited by such Proclamation are exported from Cyprus to any place or country to which their export is prohibited, or are carried coastwise, they shall be subject to forfeiture, and the person or persons exporting any such articles shall be liable to such penalties as the Governor may by any such Proclamation prescribe.

Saving.

4. Any Proclamation made by the Governor under the Cyprus Exportation of Arms Order in Council, 1903, or the Cyprus Exportation of Arms Order and Law, 1903 and 1934, shall be deemed to have been made under the provision of this Law and shall take effect accordingly.

Repeal.
41 of 1934.

5. The Cyprus Exportation of Arms Order in Council, 1903, Amendment Law, 1934, is hereby repealed.

Date of
coming into
operation.

6. This Law shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Governor by notice in the *Gazette*.
