THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 49 of 1954.

A LAW TO AMEND THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS LAW.

CAP. 19.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and
B Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Juvenile Offenders Short title.
(Amendment) Law, 1954, and shall be read as one with the
Juvenile Offenders Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Cap. 19,
principal Law").

2. Section 2 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition "probation officer" of the following definition:—

" 'probation officer' means a probation officer appointed under the provisions of the Probation of Offenders Law ;".

Amendment
of section 12
of the
principal
Law.

3. Section 12 of the principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the substitution for sub-section (1) of the following sub-section:—

"(1) Where a child or young person charged with any offence is tried by any Court and the Court is satisfied of his guilt the Court shall take into consideration the manner in which, under the provisions of this or any other Law or otherwise enabling the Court to deal with the case, the case should be dealt with, namely whether—

(a) by dismissing the charge;

(b) by dealing with the case under the various provisions of the Probation of Offenders Law ;

(c) by committing the offender to the care of a relative or other fit person ;

(d) by sending the offender to a reform school ;

(e) where an offender is a child by ordering him to be whipped ;

(f) by ordering the offender to pay a fine, damages or costs to which he is liable ; or

(g) where the offender is a young person sentence him to imprisonment for the term for which he is liable." ;

(b) by the deletion from sub-section (3) of the words "or young person" (lines 1 and 2).

4. Sections 4 and 14 of the principal Law are hereby repealed.
