**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

**No. 7 of 1957.**

A LAW TO APPROPRIATE A SUM NOT EXCEEDING TWENTY-FIVE MILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN POUNDS TO THE SERVICE OF THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDING THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN.

**W**HEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1957, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law. Preamble.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1957. Short title.

2. In addition to the sums already lawfully appropriated to the service of the Queen or which may be hereafter lawfully appropriated thereto, there shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1957, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony, any sum not exceeding the sum of Nineteen Million, Six Hundred and Sixteen Thousand One Hundred and Sixty-Six Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period as set out in columns (3) and (4) of the Schedule and there shall be issued also and applied to the service of the twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, 1957, out of the Development Fund of the Colony any sum not exceeding the sum of Six Million, Two Hundred and Twenty One Thousand and Two Hundred and Fifty-One Pounds for defraying the charge of the Government of Cyprus for such period as set out in column (5) of the Schedule.

3. A sum not exceeding the amount set down under each head in the Schedule may be issued and spent in respect of the Establishment or Service specified and referred to therein.

4. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1957.
