Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Nursing Sisters (Preservation of Rights) Law.

2. Nothing in the repeal of the Nursing Sisters Pensions Law, 1928, shall affect—

- (a) any retiring allowance granted thereunder to any matron or nursing sister;
- (b) the grant of a retiring allowance thereunder to any matron or nursing sister who ceased to serve under the Government of the Colony prior to such repeal and who would, but for such repeal, be eligible on her ultimate retirement to receive a retiring allowance under the provisions thereof in respect of her service under the Government of the Colony.
