A.D. 1930. TO AMEND THE LAW REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE  
37 of 1930. SANITATION OF THE SUMMER CAMP ON MOUNT TROÖDOS.

BE it enacted:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Troödos Public Health Law, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Troödos Public Health Law, 1920, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Troödos Public Health Laws, 1920 and 1930.

Amendment  
of section 6  
of principal  
Law.

2. The following section shall be substituted for section 6 of the principal Law:—

“6.—(1) All rates and fees received and recovered and all payments made in pursuance of the provisions of this Law or of any regulations made thereunder shall be paid into or from the Troödos public health fund.

(2) The Troödos public health fund shall be in the custody of the Chairman of the Board: Provided that the Chairman of the Board may at any time lodge or deposit any unexpended balance thereof with the Treasurer or a bank as the Governor may direct.”

Amendment  
of section 8  
of principal  
Law.

3. The principal Law, section 8, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words “any two competent persons appointed in that behalf by the Colonial Secretary” (lines 3 and 4) and the substitution therefor of the words “the Government Auditor.”
