BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus (Customs, **Short title.**

2. The First Schedule to the Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) The expression

“Cement 5*cp.* the cwt.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Cement” 4½*cp.* the cwt.”

(b) The expression

“Flour, wheaten, including semolina, and crushed or ground wheat £2. 9*s.* 6*cp.* the ton.”

shall be substituted for the expressions

“Flour of wheat or rye or maize and crushed or ground wheat and semolina—

where the price per ton *c.i.f.*

(c) The expression

“Rice 2*s.* the 100 okes.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Rice 3*s.* 4½*cp.* the 100 okes.”

(d) The expression

“Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials £1. 10*s.* the gallon.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials £1. 2*s.* 4½*cp.* the gallon.”

3. The Fourth Schedule to the Order is hereby amended as follows :—

the Order.

(a) By the deletion of the expression " Beer, ale, porter and all other malt liquors ".

(b) By the deletion of the expression " Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials . . . Ninety-five per centum of the full rate.".

(c) By the insertion therein of the following :—

" Beer, ale, porter and all other malt liquors	} Fifty per centum of the full rate.
Fish, dried, salted or pickled ..	
Rice	

Flour, wheaten, including semolina, and crushed or ground wheat	One-third of the full rate.

Cement	Sixty per centum of the full rate.

Spirits of all sorts, spirituous compounds, liqueurs and cordials—

(i) in bottles	Fifty per centum of the full rate ;

(ii) in casks	Sixty per centum of the full rate."

This Law came into operation on 16th January, 1934.
