BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Elementary Education (Amendment) Law, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1937.

2. Section 72 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows :—

(a) By the insertion in sub-section (1) thereof of the words "and, in the case of each Orthodox-Christian school in a village, together with a fee for the Chairman of the Village Commission concerned calculated at the rate of two and a half per centum on the amount required under sections 24 and 71 and appearing in such notice (but not exceeding a total fee of five pounds in any one year)," after the words "from past assessments".

(b) By the insertion of the following Proviso at the end of sub-section (10) thereof :—

"Provided that any sum representing the fee of the Chairman of the Village Commission in sub-section (1) prescribed shall, when recovered and credited to the Education (A) Fund, be paid out of the said Fund to the Chairman of the Village Commission concerned."

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Village Obligations (Amendment) Law, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Village Obligations Laws, 1901 and 1928, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Village Obligations Laws, 1901 to 1937.

2. Section 11 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By the insertion in sub-section (1) thereof of the words “and which amount of money shall include a fee of ten shillings for the Mukhtar” after the words “each householder and proprietor”.

(b) By the insertion in sub-section (2) thereof of the words “and for the payment of the fee of the Mukhtar in sub-section (1) prescribed” after the words “of such contract or obligation”.

3. Sub-section (6) of section 12 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of the words “and out of the moneys received and credited as aforesaid there shall be paid to the Mukhtar a sum equal to the amount received in respect of the fee of the Mukhtar in section 11 (1) prescribed” after the words “the person belongs”.

2. Paragraph (1) (ii) of Schedule 2 to the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By the deletion of the expression “of 2s.” and by the substitution therefor of the expression “of four shillings”.

(b) By the deletion of the expression “or 1s.” and by the substitution therefor of the expression “or two shillings”.
