A LAW TO AMEND THE GAME AND WILD BIRDS LAW, 1934.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.
3 of 1934.

1. This Law may be cited as the Game and Wild Birds (Amendment) Law, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Game and Wild Birds Law, 1934, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Game and Wild Birds Laws, 1934 and 1938.

Insertion of

9A in Law 3
of 1934.

2. The following section shall be inserted in the Principal Law immediately after section 9 thereof:—

"Possession
of fresh
carcass of
moufflon or
of any fresh
part of
dead
moufflon
prohibited.

9A. Any person, other than a person who is the holder of a special permit from the Governor granted under section 9 (1) and subsisting for the time being, who is found in possession—

- (a) of the fresh carcass of a moufflon, or
(b) of any fresh part of a dead moufflon,

shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds or to both."

14(1) of Law
3 of 1934.

3. Sub-section (1) of section 14 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (b) from the proviso thereto and by the substitution therefor of the following paragraph:—

"(b) save in the Nicosia District and in the Paphos District, no Game Reserve shall exceed twenty square miles in extent."

Amendment
of section 18
of Law 3 of
1934.

4. Section 18 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion of the following proviso at the end thereof:—

"Provided that the Governor may at any time issue a permit authorizing any person in the interests of science to export game."
