THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 19 OF 1946.

A LAW TO AMEND THE TOBACCO LAWS, 1932 TO 1945.

Governor.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Tobacco (Amendment) Law, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Tobacco Laws, 1932 to 1946.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 40 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraphs (a) and (b) and the substitution therefor of the following paragraphs:—

“(a) such tobacco is packed in separate packets each containing a net weight of manufactured tobacco being not less nor more than four drams or any multiple of four drams:

Provided that in any packet of manufactured tobacco made into cigarettes the number of cigarettes shall not exceed sixteen for every four drams of manufactured tobacco contained therein;

(b) every packet containing manufactured tobacco not being tobacco made into cigarettes, snuff or chewing tobacco contains cigarette paper in the proportion of thirty cigarette papers to every eight drams of manufactured tobacco. Such cigarette paper shall have the name of the manufacturer printed thereon in such manner as the Comptroller may from time to time prescribe;”

3. This Law shall come into operation on the 1st day of November, 1946.
