A LAW TO AMEND THE CYPRUS LAWS (NEW EDITION).

Officer Administering the Government.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title. **1.** This Law may be cited as the New Edition (Amendments) Law, 1951.

Amendment of Laws in the Schedule. **2.** The several Laws set out in the first column of the Schedule hereto are hereby amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the second column of such Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

1. Criminal Code Law (Cap. 13 and Laws 27 of 1949 and 12 of 1951).	<p>1.—(a) Deletion in section 12 of the word “affects” (line 9) and substitution therefor of the word “effects”.</p> <p>(b) Deletion in paragraph (d) of section 60 of the word “prescribed” (line 7) and substitution therefor of the word “proscribed”.</p>
2. Forest Law (Cap. 93).	2. Deletion in section 5 of the word “Government” (line 1) and substitution therefor of the word “Governor”.
3. Dealings between Merchants and Farmers Law (Cap. 193).	3. Deletion in section 10 of the word “on” (line 3) and substitution therefor of the word “or”.
4. Infants’ Estates Administration Law (Cap. 218 and Law 6 of 1951).	4. Deletion in section 59 of the word “immovable” (line 1) and substitution therefor of the word “movable”.
