THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS

No. 8 OF 1957.

A LAW TO AMEND THE BREWERIES LAWS, 1950 AND 1954. 21 of 1950

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and  
Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as  
follows :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Breweries (Amendment) Law, Short title.  
21 of 1950  
22 of 1954  
1957, and shall be read as one with the Breweries Laws, 1950 and  
1954 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law"), and the  
principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Breweries  
Laws, 1950 to 1957.

Repeal of section 12 of the principal Law and substitution of new section.

2. Section 12 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“ Imposition of excise duty.

12.—(1) Upon and after the enactment of this Law, there shall be levied and paid upon beer manufactured and issued for consumption in the Colony an excise duty at the rate of one hundred mils on each gallon :

Provided that where beer manufactured in the Colony, not being in excess of such quantities as the Governor may, from time to time, by Order specify, is delivered from a brewer's premises to the Navy, Army and Air Force Institutes for sale to members of Her Majesty's Forces serving in the Colony and is certified to be received for such sale by the person in charge of the Navy, Army and Air Force Institutes in the Colony or his deputy, the excise duty which shall be levied and paid upon such beer shall be at the rate of fifty mils on each gallon.

(2) The Governor-in-Council may, by Order published in the *Gazette*, reduce, increase or otherwise vary the rate of excise duty and may abolish such duty and re-impose the same :

Provided that no increase shall exceed by more than one hundred per centum the rates specified in sub-section (1).”

3. This Law shall be deemed to have come into operation on the eleventh day of February, 1957.
